WHEREAS: The College of Charleston is the 13th oldest institution for higher education in the country.

WHEREAS: The College of Charleston is the oldest municipal college in the country.

WHEREAS: Due to the historical significance of the College of Charleston, it is deserving of having a commemorative stamp.

WHEREAS: The Charleston community has expressed support for a commemorative stamp, as can be seen in resolutions from the Charleston County and City Council expressing support as well as a letter of support from Mayor Tecklenburg.


WHEREAS: Support has been expressed from across the state, as can be seen in that eight of the nine members of South Carolina's congressional delegation have signed a letter expressing support of the stamp.

WHEREAS: Approximately 50,000 requests for commemorative stamps are submitted each year so the College needs as much support as possible to compete with these other requests, which is why it would be beneficial to show student support for the stamp.

THEREFORE: BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING

SECTION I: The Student Government Association of the College of Charleston supports the adoption of a commemorative stamp in honor of the College's 250th Anniversary.

SECTION II: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY THE STUDENT SENATE SITTING IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE SIGNATURE OF THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT.
